The California State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) has received the August 26, 2020, letter continuing consultation regarding an undertaking at NASA Ames Research Center (ARC). NASA is consulting with the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) to comply with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (54 U.S.C. §306108), as amended, and its implementing regulations at 36 CFR Part 800 and the *Memorandum of Agreement between National Aeronautics and Space Administration Ames Research Center and the California State Historic Preservation Officer Regarding the Planetary Ventures Navigational Aids, Airfield Lighting and Signage Replacement (NAVAIDS) Project, Moffett Field, Santa Clara County, California* (executed October 19, 2018).
