

Building 93 is a 26'x 64' Quonset hut with corrugated metal walls set on high poured-in-place reinforced-concrete side walls. Eight vents extend from the roof. Metal single and double doors provide access on the north. Four-pane double-hung windows in metal sash are located on the east and west walls. A one-over-one double-hung window in wood sash is located on the north side. A shed-roof concrete block addition extends from the south side, with aluminum-frame sliding windows on the south, east, and west sides. A metal double door provides access on the west side.

The shed roofs of the main block join at different heights allowing for a row of fixed clerestory windows on the north side.
