Building 152 is a large multiple use building consisting of a rectangular one-story dining hall connected to a one and two-story warehouse with a loading ramp. Built of concrete, the dining hall portion has a shallow-pitched gable roof and the warehouse portion has a flat roof. A two-story utilities tower juts from the warehouse roof. Tall ribbon windows light the dining hall. A concrete arcade running the length of the east side shelters the five metal and glass entrance doors. High ribbon windows are located in the warehouse portion. A roll-up door and metal double doors provide access on the west and south sides of the warehouse. A concrete block utilities building has been attached to the northwest side of the dining hall.
