Building 484 is a 68'x 109' two-bay rectangle, with concrete lower walls topped by cement-asbestos ribbed panels. The lower shed-roof bay has a metal personnel door and a metal industrial sliding door. The higher shed-roof bay has a high double sliding door with a metal crane structure extending from it. A shed-roof wing extends to the west. Six large lightning rod poles and numerous light poles surround the building. It is located within a secured chain-link fence enclosure that also contains the sentry house (485) and magazines (486-492).

This building was used as an office and for testing and assembling the weapons inventory for the P-3 mission. It is directly associated with the Cold War P-3 Orion anti-submarine warfare patrol mission at Moffett Field dating from 1963-1994. Although this mission is considered of exceptional national significance within the Cold War context, this building is of a standard Navy Bureau of Yards and Docks secure munitions design and does not exhibit unique architectural or engineering features special to the P-3 mission. It is therefore not considered of exceptional significance under criterion G.
