Building 650 is a rectangular one-story flat-roofed building on a concrete foundation. The fluted concrete slab walls are topped by porcelain enamel fascia panels. An entrance wing with reflective glass walls and porcelain enamel fascia panels extends to the north. Metal single or double doors provide access on the north, west, and south sides.

Building 650 housed the avionics shop and electronics repair and maintenance shop for the avionics component boxes found on the P-3 Orion. This building was directly associated with the Cold War P-3 Orion anti-submarine warfare patrol mission dating from 1963 to 1994. Although this mission is considered of exceptional national significance within the Cold War context, this building is of standard construction and does not exhibit unique architectural or engineering features special to the P-3 mission. It is therefore not considered of exceptional significance under criterion G.

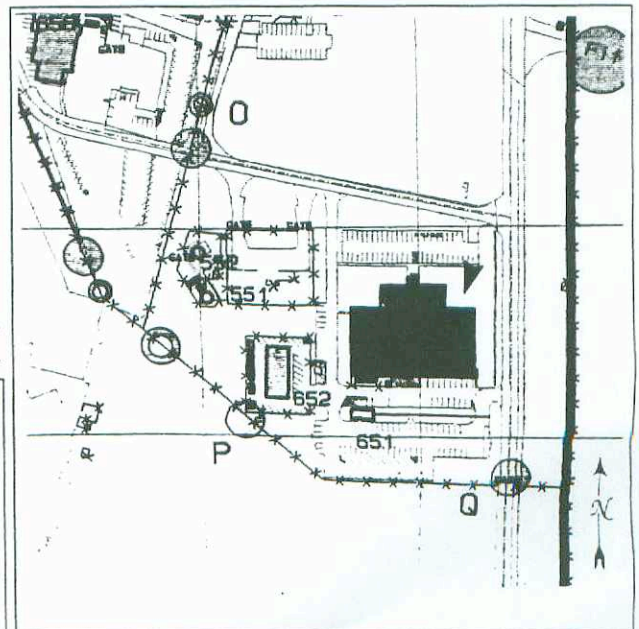
