Building 653 is a post-modern one-story rectangular building, constructed of scored concrete, with a square office and lobby wing attached to the south. High ribbon windows with decorative metal louvers are located on the south side. A high one-story section with a clerestory window is located on the north side, housing the ordnance bay. A high overhead door on the west side provides access to this bay. Reflective glass double doors provide access to the lobby on the east and west sides. Decorative elements include the curved clerestory window detail, window louvers, and scored concrete panels.

This building provided classrooms for applied instruction in maintenance of P-3 Orions. This building was directly associated with the Cold War P-3 Orion anti-submarine warfare patrol mission dating from 1963 to 1994. Although this mission is considered of exceptional national significance within the Cold War context, this building is of standard construction in the Post-Modern style and does not exhibit unique architectural or engineering features special to the P-3 mission. It is therefore not considered of exceptional significance under criterion G.
