Building 654 is a one-story flat-roofed rectangular concrete building with concrete piers along the east and west sides. A flat-roof Butler pre-fabricated metal shed for the HVAC system extends to the north. Three sets of metal double doors provide access on the west side. New tinted fixed windows in metal frames have been inset in the east and west sides. A new tinted glass and metal door, sheltered by a concrete canopy, provides access on the south side.

With buildings 655 and 669, this classroom building was part of "Orion University" that trained P-3 Orion pilots and technical crews. It has been remodeled for new use. This building was directly associated with the Cold War P-3 Orion anti-submarine warfare patrol mission dating from 1963 to 1994 at Moffett Field. Although this mission is considered of exceptional national significance within the Cold War context, this building is of standard construction and does not exhibit unique architectural or engineering features special to the P-3 mission. It is therefore not considered of exceptional significance under criterion G.
