This rectangular one-story pre-fabricated building with corrugated metal walls sits on a concrete foundation. The medium-pitched gable roof is metal. Metal single and double doors provide access on the north and south sides. Three roll-up metal doors have been added on the west side. Fixed and transom multi-paned windows in metal sash provide light on the west side. A shed-roof boiler room is attached to the east side

With buildings 654 and 669, this was part of "Orion University" that trained P-3 Orion pilots and technical crews. This building was directly associated with the Cold War P-3 Orion anti-submarine warfare patrol mission dating from 1963 to 1994 at Moffett Field. Although this mission is considered of exceptional national significance within the Cold War context, this building is of standard World War II construction and does not exhibit unique architectural or engineering modifications special to the P-3 mission. It is therefore not considered of exceptional significance under criterion G.
